A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF TUCSON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1 OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA AFFIRMING ITS COMMITMENT TO STUDENTS REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS

WHEREAS, the Tucson Unified School District ("the District") exists for the purpose of providing a free public education to children residing in Arizona;

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court, in the case of *Plyler v. Doe*, held that the denial of equal educational opportunities to students on the basis of their immigration status (whether documented or not) was a discriminatory violation of the United States Constitution;
