

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF  
TUCSON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1  
OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA  
AFFIRMING ITS COMMITMENT TO STUDENTS  
REGARDLESS OF IMMIGRATION STATUS

WHEREAS, the Tucson Unified School District ("the District") exists for the purpose of providing a free public education to children residing in Arizona;

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court, in the case of Plyler v. Doe, held that the denial of equal educational opportunities to students on the basis of their immigration status (whether documented or not) was an invidious violation of the United States Constitution;

WHEREAS, the District serves numerous immigrant families and their children;
